LTC Bagwell:


I am the attorney representing Daryl Beamer in a pending state robbery case. I thank you for speaking openly with me on the phone last week concerning this situation.

As you may recall, we believe Daryl Beamer has developed some serious issues related to his mental health as a direct result of his service in the military. It is our position that the military has failed to provide the help that he desperately needed, and because his problems went untreated, he is now in jail facing serious state criminal charges.

Our request is that the military now make treatment available to Daryl Beamer. If the military can offer an appropriate residential treatment program, we will then ask the court to temporarily release him from jail for the purposes of attending treatment. I believe the court would agree provided there is a highly structured plan in place.

What treatment can the military provide to Daryl Beamer?

Mr. Mahlen:

I am in receipt of your letter requesting in-patient mental health treatment for Specialist Daryl Beamer. The U.S. Army Alaska Commander, based upon my recommendation, has denied your request. My recommendation to him was made after careful consultation with Army mental healthcare providers and is based upon Specialist Beamer's mental health records, prior treatment record, VA treatment protocols, and the programs available for the requested treatment. This includes the fact that none of the military residential treatment programs are equipped to handle someone who is charged with committing violent and serious offenses such as armed robbery.
